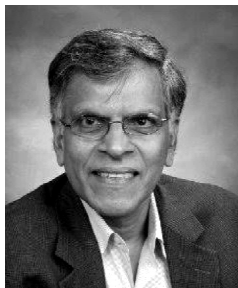


Editorial
